Norwegian Reading Corner – by Sharon Wikan

I wanted to share information on a couple of books that our members might enjoy if they have not already read. They are available at the Petersburg Library and if you are out of town, you may go to your public library and ask about their inter-library loan program. The books are located in the Petersburg section, and there are more available.



Alaska Panhandle Tales by Jack O'Donnell. He was born in Alaska and the stories are about life in the 1920's to 1950's of Southeast Alaska. Jack was a bear guide and commercial fisherman. Many, many fun stories, such as Papke, fish traps, Johnny Sales, bear and fox farms, girls in Warm Springs and 4th of July and many more.

There Never Was Another Time by Sharlene Greenaway Pilkey. She was born in Petersburg in 1935. The stories are from about 1935 to 1950s. It includes recipes too, but I skipped over them. Also, part of her life after Petersburg. Take a look at it - the first paragraph will get you hooked. I vaguely remember hearing bits and pieces of the stories.

Another book is *A Frog in the Fjord* by Lorelou Desjardins. It's out in paperback. It's about a French gal going to Norway and living there for a year. Her story is about some of the quirky differences Norwegians have, and just life in current Norway. It's an easy read and again, great humor.
